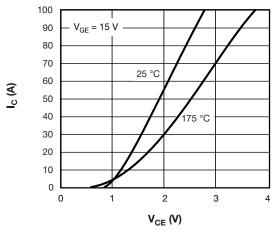
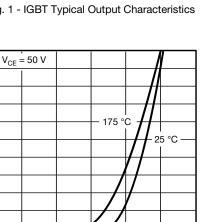


Fig. 1 - IGBT Typical Output Characteristics

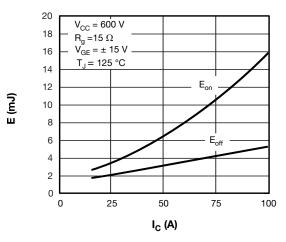


Fig. 3 - IGBT Switching Loss vs. I<sub>C</sub>

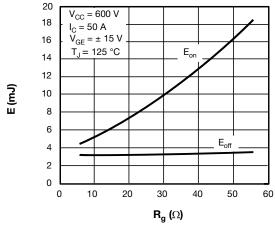


Fig. 4 - IGBT Switching Loss vs. R<sub>G</sub>

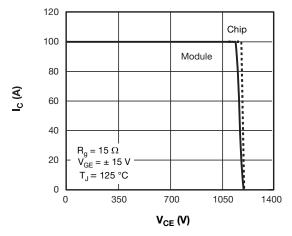


Fig. 5 - RBSOA

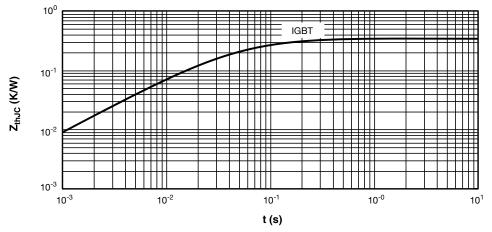


Fig. 6 - IGBT Transient Thermal Impedance

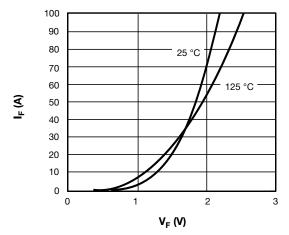


Fig. 7 - Diode Forward Characteristics

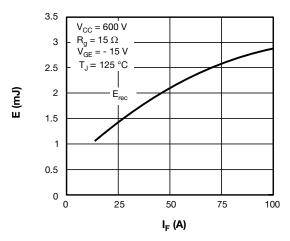


Fig. 8 - Diode Switching Loss vs. I<sub>F</sub>

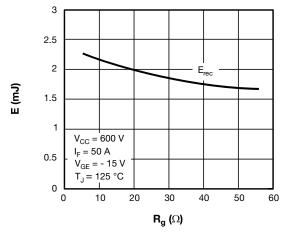


Fig. 9 - Diode Switching Loss vs. R<sub>G</sub>

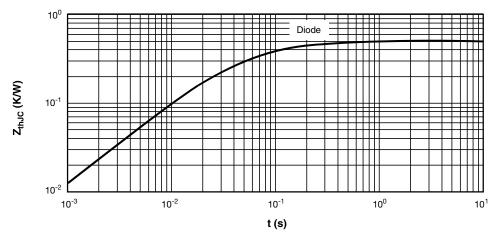
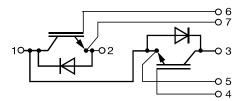


Fig. 10 - Diode Transient Thermal Impedance
