








On-Resistance vs. Drain Current









On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature (1.8 A)




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage (1.8 A)




Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage



On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature (2.4 A)




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage (2.4 A)







Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature




Safe Operating Area
