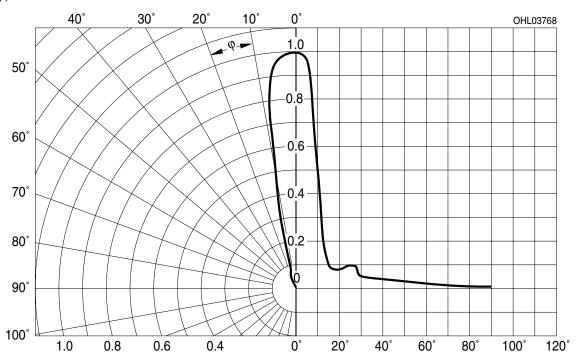

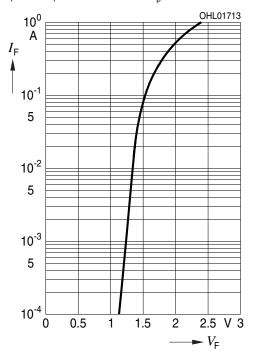

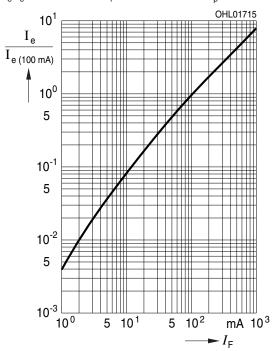

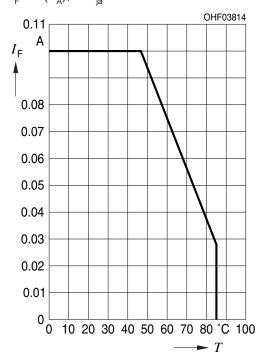

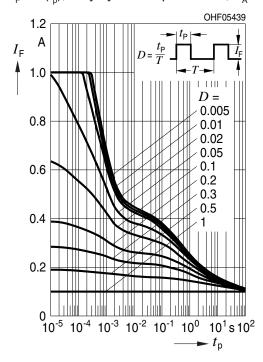

Permissible Pulse Handling Capability

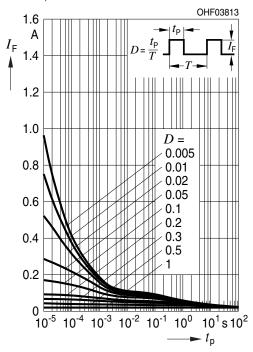

Applying any continuous reverse bias or forward bias below the voltage range of light emission shall be avoided because it may cause migration which can change the electro-optical characteristics or damage the LED.
- 4) Forward Voltage: The forward voltages are measured with a tolerance of ±0.1 V.
- 5) Total radiant flux: Measured with integrating sphere.
- 6) Thermal resistance: junction - ambient, mounted on PC-board (FR4), padsize 20 mm² each
- 7) Typical Values: Due to the special conditions of the manufacturing processes of semiconductor devices, the typical data or calculated correlations of technical parameters can only reflect statistical figures.
