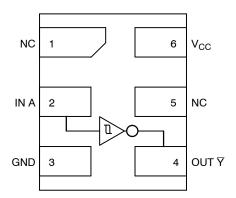


Figure 1. Pinout (Top View)

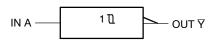


Figure 2. Logic Symbol

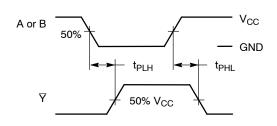
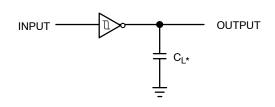


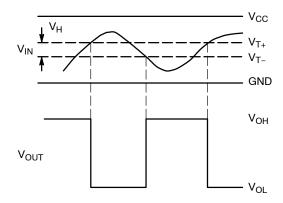
Figure 3. Switching Waveforms

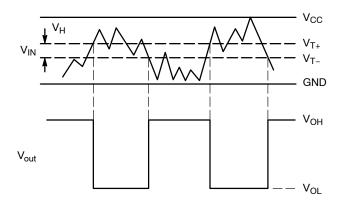

Figure 5. Typical Schmitt-Trigger Applications

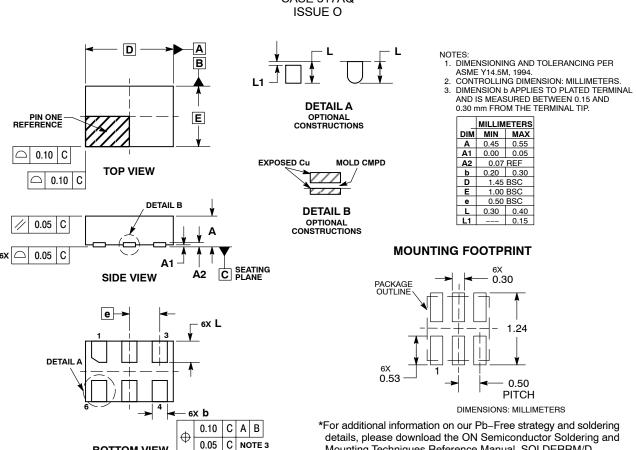

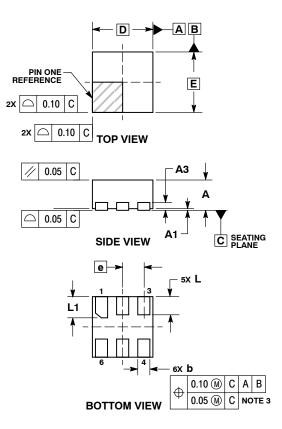

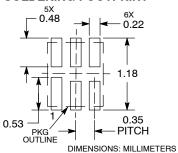

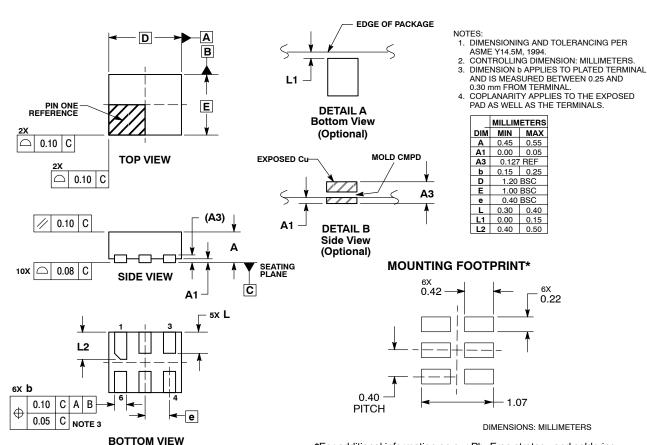
